Altogether, **43** independent European networks of civil society organisations (CSOs) specialised in different sectors contributed to this report.

The **report will be publicly launched and presented** on Wednesday 6 September 2023 in Brussels and online, from 16:00 to 17:00 (CET). This will be **followed by a <u>networking</u> reception until 18:30**.
